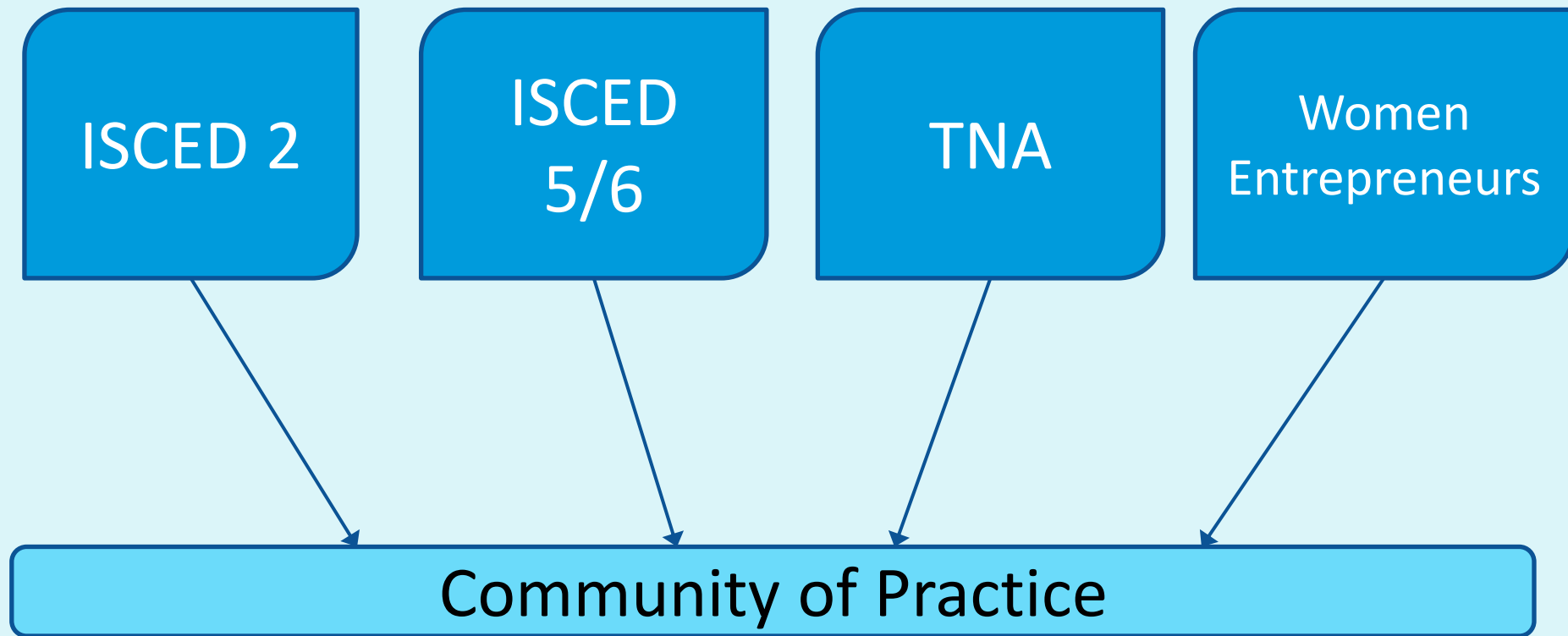

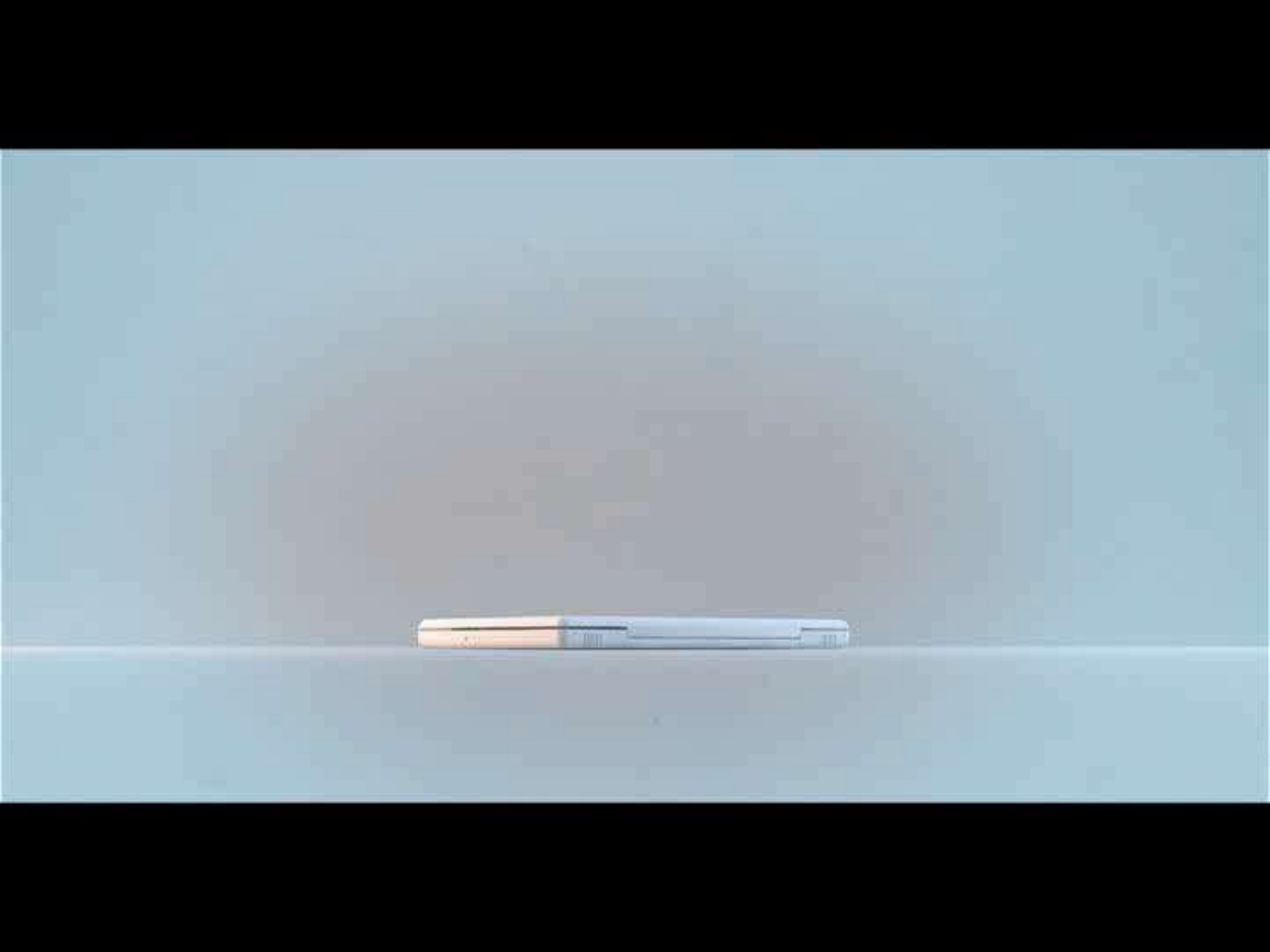


Strategic Network of Pilot Institutions

- Institutions:

 - 2 HEI*s per country: 16 HEIs
 - 1 business association per country: 8 institutions
 - 1 women business association per country: 9 institutions**
- TOTAL: 65 institutions – strategic piloting network
