# 2020 Achievements of the Roma Integration project

- Co-organized with AL Government a Poznan Declaration Ministerial meeting with concrete follow up conclusions
  - Endorsed at the WB Leaders' Summit in Sofia
- Mapping of illegal settlements has started
  - Created a software for data gathering of the mapping process
- Developed roadmaps for ending statelessness among Roma
  - Official adoption pending





# 2020 Achievements of the Roma Integration project

- Developed a model framework to guide the drafting of the post-2020 National Roma Integration Strategies
  - Pending official endorsement
- Started working on legalization cases of housing units in the municipalities of Nis and Leskovac in Serbia
- Developing programs on transforming undeclared work in Serbia and North Macedonia





# 2020 Achievements of the Roma Integration project

- Increased presence in the media in order to promote the fight against antigypsyism, positive stories and case studies;
- Coordination of COVID-19 emergency response meetings
  - Raised the voices of Roma communities
  - Policy proposals and contributions to IPA reprogramming;
  - Public budgeting reprograming using Roma responsive budgeting principles.

# Mapping of informal settlements and update on the piloting process

- Roma settlements are mapped in two municipalities per economy
- Database of the Roma settlements is being developed on the QGIS platform
- Training on the QGIS platform conducted for government officials
- Mapping should be finalized by the end of 2021
- Discussion should focus on how the mapping process can be completed, what are the needs?





#### Roadmaps for ending statelessness

- Developed and proposed to the governments
- ENS has been actively engaged in the process
- Official endorsement is expected in 2021
- Discussions should focus on what is expected from RCC, from UNHCR, from ENS







#### Roma responsive budgeting

- Not taken into account in the rebalance of public budgets for 2020
  - In some cases, significant budget cuts where made from the dedicated Roma integration budgets
- Will require full involvement of various stakeholders, including Ministries of Finance
- Example of Albania should serve as good practice and basis for peer-learning (especially at local level)







#### Monitoring and data collection

- Expert on developing the methodology for the Roma Survey is engaged and working
- Pilot survey is expected after the 2021 census results are available (for sampling)
- FRA is involved and consulted in the process
- We must consider involving the State Statistical agencies!

#### The new EU Roma Strategic Framework

- RCC provides technical assistance in the process
- Deadline for official adoption of NRIS is September 2021 (discussion on individual dynamics)
- Proposal for guidelines and a model National Roma Strategic Frameworks
- Recommended targets aligned with the Poznan Declaration, the EU Framework and the local context
