At the end of the Slovak presidency we should have:

- a methodological handbook for revision of NAPs. This handbook will be a practical guidance to instruct countries of the Decade how to revise their NAPs' indicators, making progress monitoring possible,
  - modification of indicators of Slovak NAP, according to the developed methodology, revision of process of monitoring.

## Time schedule

September 2009 – December 2009: development of methodology and drafting of the handbook, December 2009: international round-table, January 2010 – July 2010: revision of Slovak NAP, based on the developed methodology, February 2010 – April 2010: establishment of WG and 3 working group's meetings
