

Establishing Realities




Vast majority of Roma do <u>not</u> depend on social assistance


% Households receiving social assistance



Nearly all Roma parents think that early childhood education is important for <u>having a good future</u>





Roma are much less likely to be working than non-Roma.....




....but Roma want to work but cannot find jobs

% Working age population participating in labor force (male – female)








Equal labor market opportunities would generate substantial fiscal benefits



 - Participatory and transparent monitoring (e.g., against territorial tools)




Bulgaria, LAU 1 level ('nuts 4') – 262 municipalities (2005)
