- We participate in the preparation of the Decade of Roma since 2003 and we are a member from the beginning of its starting on 2 February, 2005.
- In 2005 the Government of the Republic of Macedonia have bring and adopted a "National Strategy for Roma in Macedonia" and appointed a National Coordinating Body
- In 2009, the National Action Plans were reviewed.
- In Macedonia, the Decade of Roma at the ministerial level through the appointment of Minister of National Coordinator for the implementation of its activities
