

Main problems that characterise safety conditions of the Roma

- Marginalisation of incidents by political structures, which can be classified as:
- 1. Intimidation
- 2. Absence of adequate safety policies and their integration into wider political community
- 3. Dysfunction of the courts and their ethnic bias
- 4. Politicisation, instrumentalisation of media for the obstruction of reforms within the Decade of the Roma
- 5. Political exclusivity and intolerance
- 6. Absence of civil (and national) control of the work of police and intelligence services that burden political and public life
- 7. Absence of political will and willingness to cooperate with the Roma civil organisations and to accept responsibility for tolerant and bias relation towards the perpetrators of ethnically motivated crimes




Do you personally feel safe?






In which period did you feel the safest?






In which period did you feel the least safe?






What is the main threat for safety of the Roma?





Who is responsible for you personal safety?












How many ethnic incidents there were in 2012 and 2013 in your town in total?
